



#### Who Was Interviewed







### Prop 4

The constitutional amendment to dedicate a portion of the revenue derived from state sales and use taxes to the Texas water fund and to provide for the allocation and use of that revenue


Texas' aging, leaking water systems lose about 88 billion gallons of water each year through leaks, and Prop 4 will help fund needed repairs and replacement of aging water pipes.




Some Texas communities have less water than others, and this can cause some people to have to move. Prop 4 would provide a more reliable supply of water so that people would stay in the communities where they currently live.




Prop 4 will fund one billion dollars of water projects per year for the next 20 years without any tax increase because the revenue will come from the existing state sales tax.



Prop 4 will dedicate \$1 billion per year of state sales tax revenue to water supply and infrastructure projects for each of the next 20 years.
